

Abstract Reasoning Test (ART)

The Abstract Reasoning Test provides a thorough, stand-alone measure of abstract reasoning. It takes 30 minutes plus administration time to complete. This test is suitable for combination with other measures of high level thinking, for instance the Critical Reasoning Test Battery.

Subtests & Constructs

Abstract Reasoning: The ART assesses an individual's capacity to perceive logical patterns and relationships and extrapolate from these. Sometimes referred to as Fluid Intelligence, this is considered the purest form of general mental ability and is not dependent on cultural background or educational experience.

Particularly suitable for graduate, managerial and professional groups • Minimum educational level: Grade 12 • Classified as psychological in nature by the Professional Board for Psychology.
