## REPORT STRUCTURE

The Critical Reasoning Test Battery assesses your capacity (a composite of speed and accuracy) to arrive at logical decisions based on complex information. This incorporates the ability to: weigh evidence logically; identify trends in data; isolate the key points in an argument; understand complex arguments; assimilate evidence; process information quickly; make well-informed business decisions and solve problems effectively.

## VERBAL CRITICAL REASONING

### Scale Description

The Verbal Critical Reasoning Test measures an individual's ability to reason using words, and draw inferences and logical conclusions from them. This includes both an understanding of the meaning of words and the relationships between them. The results have been compared to a high scoring group of graduate or equivalent ability.

### Result Description

Compared to the reference group, your performance on the Verbal Critical Reasoning Test places you slightly below average. This suggests that your ability to critically evaluate written arguments and accurately deduce the logical consequences of such arguments may be a little weaker than that of many graduates and managers. While you should have little difficulty understanding reports and written instructions and explanations, it may take you some time to fully appreciate the subtle shades of meaning which are contained in such texts. A little less able than many graduates and managers to fully understand the complex logic which underlies a given textual argument you should nonetheless be able to use words in a fairly logical, rational way.



## NUMERICAL CRITICAL REASONING

### Scale Description

The Numerical Critical Reasoning Test measures the individual's ability to use and manipulate numbers in a logical way. This includes both an understanding of numbers and the relationships between them.

### Result Description

Your performance on the Numerical Critical Reasoning Test puts you in the top 5% when compared to the reference group. This clearly demonstrates that you have a very strong grasp of numerical concepts and a good ability to understand numerical information. Much more able than most graduates and managers to understand numerical tables and interpret this information in a logical, rational way, you have a strong ability to use this information to accurately draw inferences and conclusions from the data. Consequently, you should be more than able to cope with the demands of jobs which involve processing numerical information and basing decisions upon such information.
